


VFW WOMEN VETERANS SURVEY FINDINGS:


he Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States' (VFW) survey of women veterans was conducted from December 21, 2015 to January 18, 2016 and received 2,475 responses. The survey was logic-based, meaning the questions participants were prompted to answer were based on their initial responses. To ensure only women veterans answered the survey, the VFW screened for participants' gender and service status. Nearly 2,000 participants responded being female and active duty, reserve/guard, military retiree, or veteran. Below is a summary of the results.





