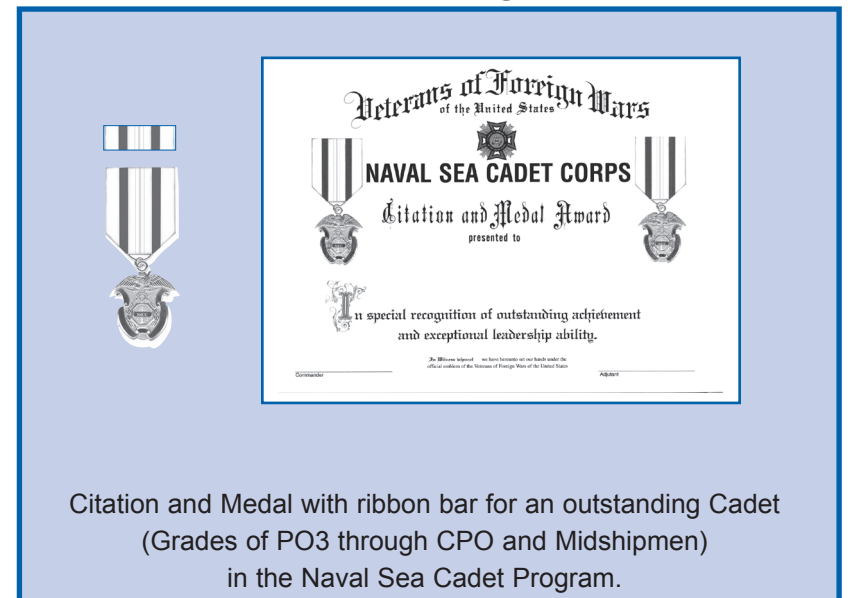

# VFW POST RECOGNITION OF THE NAVAL SEA CADET CORPS CADETS

- ⇒ If there is a Naval Sea Cadet unit in your area, this is an excellent opportunity for your Post to be active in youth programs.
- ⇒ The VFW Sea Cadet awards for special recognition of outstanding achievements and exceptional leadership for Sea Cadet Petty Officers and Midshipmen.
- ⇒ The criteria and award have been approved by the Naval Sea Cadet Corps.
- ⇒ The criteria for selecting the recipient of the VFW award for Naval Sea Cadet Petty Officers and Midshipmen follow:

## NAVAL SEA CADET AWARD

1. **Description:** A medal pendant with matching ribbon. The ribbon is  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches in length,  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch in width, overall white with purple and gold stripes.
2. **Eligibility:** Sea Cadets in grades of PO3 through CPO and Midshipmen.
3. **Criteria:**
  - a) Be in good standing academically.
  - b) Progressing satisfactorily in the Sea Cadet program.
  - c) Demonstrated outstanding achievement in:
    1. Community Service
    2. Cadet Naval Education
  - d) Demonstrated outstanding leadership in the Naval Sea Cadet Corps.
  - e) Must be of high moral character.
  - f) Displays outstanding military bearing and conduct both in and out of uniform.
  - g) Patriotism (Member of unit color guard or drill team and actively promotes Americanism.)
  - h) Demonstrates growth potential (assumes higher levels of responsibility.)
  - i) Must not have been a previous recipient of the award.
4. **Administration:** The recipient of the award will be selected by the individual's Unit Commanding Officer. A business letter with attached justification, addressing the criteria will be submitted to VFW HQ, Department of Youth Development, Scholarship and Recognition Programs with a courtesy copy to NSCC HQ. Each unit is encouraged to submit ONE cadet for this award.
5. **Presentation:** It is recommended that the award be presented annually at an appropriate ceremony such as inspections, open houses, September Sea Cadet Anniversary events, etc. It is further recommended that a Post Commander or a representative of the VFW present the award.
